

Aletheia Devices and Internet Acceptable Use Policy

Aletheia Christian Academy recognizes the value of computer and other electronic devices to improve student learning and enhance the administration and operation of its schools. To this end, ACA encourages the responsible use of computers, iPads, computer networks, including the Internet; and other electronic resources in support of the mission and goals of Aletheia Christian Academy.

The internet expands classroom and media resources by providing access to information, images, and computer software from sources otherwise impossible to reach. This resource provides a rich environment for individual and group projects, collaboration, curriculum and idea sharing. Along with the above advantages of internet use comes some risks. These risks include:

- Access to inappropriate websites
- The transmission of personal information via email to strangers
- The spreading of computer viruses into school computers

Aletheia Christian Academy has made every effort to minimize these risks. The actions that have been taken include:

- Installed an internet filter/firewall to minimize the chance of accessing an inappropriate website.
- Installed virus protection and anti-spyware software
- Close supervision of the students by the teacher.
- Educating students as to what they should and should not be doing on the internet.

Even with all the above steps, ACA cannot guarantee that your student will not be exposed to some inappropriate material. We do guarantee that we will take every step possible to prevent it and will promptly inform you if something inappropriate does happen.

The most important safeguard for students is that they act wisely and responsibly while on the internet. Therefore, **in order for a student to use the internet at ACA they must agree to the following rules:**

1. All use of the Internet must be in support of educational and research objectives consistent with the mission and objectives of Aletheia Christian Academy.
2. Students cannot send out an email unless they are given specific permission by a teacher to do so. When using e-mail, extreme caution must always be taken in revealing any information of a personal nature.
3. Network accounts are to be used only by the authorized owner of the account for the authorized purpose.
4. Students cannot intentionally access inappropriate or obscene websites. If an inappropriate website is unintentionally accessed, the student should exit the website immediately and inform their teacher.
5. Students can use the internet only if given permission to do so by a teacher and that teacher is present to supervise them.
6. Students may not access any social networking site without permission.
7. Students should be careful not to violate any copyright or use in any way another person's intellectual property without permission.

In addition to the above rules for using the internet at Aletheia, below are listed the rules for using Aletheia's computers, iPads, or other devices.

- You may use an assigned computer, iPad, or other device only with your teacher's permission, and the teacher must be present in the library.
- Do not have food, drinks, candy, or gum by the devices.
- Do not print anything without permission.
- Do not change any settings, add any shortcuts, or otherwise make any adjustments on the devices.
- Log in under your name only. Do not use nicknames or fictitious names. Do not get into anyone else's records.
- Do not attempt to install or download any programs.
