Personal Computer Acceptable Use Policy

Aletheia Christian Academy provides computers for our students to use to further their education. Sometimes a student requests to use his/her personal lap top computer to work on assignments or FLVS. This is a privilege, and the expectations listed below should be respected.

In order for a student to use their personal computer at ACA they must agree to the following rules:

1. You may use your personal computer only with your teacher's permission and the teacher must be present at all times.
2. Your computer will be for your use only. Students will not be allowed to share their personal computers.
3. The school is *not responsible* for your computer while it is at school. It is the responsibility of the student to take care of his/her own computer.
4. Once the assignment is complete, the computer should be turned off.
5. Students may not print to any Aletheia printer without permission.
6. All use of the Internet must be in support of educational and research objectives consistent with the mission and objectives of Aletheia Christian Academy.
7. Students cannot sign on to the internet without a teacher's permission and a clear reason to do so.
8. Students may not use the internet to "surf" websites while at school.
9. Students cannot intentionally access inappropriate or obscene websites. If an inappropriate website is unintentionally accessed, the student should exit the website immediately and inform their teacher.
10. Students may not access any social networking site without permission.
