Please bring the following items to Pre-K Open House. Please put the items in a grocery bag (paper or plastic) labeled with your child's name.

- Non-returnable picture of your child
- Non-returnable picture of your family
- 4 large pencils
- 2, 24-packs of crayons (or larger -- any size will do)
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors (Blunt)

Kindergarten Supply List 2010-2011

**All items should be brought to school between August 3rd
and Open House on August 5th.**

- Change of uniform in a labeled plastic Zip-lock bag (please include pants, Polo shirt and undergarments)
- 1 White 100% cotton T-shirt (without stain guard) that is LARGE on your child, almost to knees, for an Indian shirt at Thanksgiving
- 1 picture of your family (3 x 5 or 4 x 6) AND 1 picture of your child (same size) for memory book
- 1 roll of paper towels now and 1 in January
- 1 box of Kleenex now and 1 in January
- Last name A-H: 1 sheet of poster board
- Last name I-Z: 1 ream red, bright yellow, orange, green, or multi-colored card stock
- 1 package of pencils AND 1 package colored pencils
- 1 box of crayons (any size box)
- 1 composition book (example: black & white bound -- not limited to this style)
- 1 box Zip-lock bags (2-gallon, gallon, or quart)
- 2 small glue sticks
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 bubble pencil gripper from Learning World
- 1 Dry erase board (approximately 8 x 11") AND 3-4 Dry erase markers
- 1 old wash cloth
- Bible - complete text, any version (Elementary uses NKJ)
- Tote bag - (not a backpack, please) 12 x 14 minimum, open at the top with handles and no zippers.
Inexpensive canvas or denim bags can be found at Walmart in the craft section or in Hobby Lobby or Michaels. You can decorate them any way you choose.
- Lunch box or small cooler for your child's lunch / snack
- 1 package of wrapped candy for treasures
- Antibacterial Wet Wipes (pop-up canister type)
- Optional: Little toy treasures your child doesn't play with anymore : i.e. little planes, cars, animals, etc.

First Grade Supply List 2010-2011

Please write your child's name or initials directly on all items, not packages, unless otherwise specified. Fine point Sharpie pens are useful for labeling small items.

- Canvas tote bag, 10x13" or larger, open at the top, no zipper -- NOT a backpack. Available at Wal-Mart, Target, hobby stores, etc. Can decorate any way you choose.
- Zippered pencil pouch (must hold crayons, scissors, glue stick, washcloth, and marker)
- 1 8-10 count package washable markers (please, no larger packs)
- 1 pair child-sized scissors
- 2 Glue Sticks
- 4 Large (rubber) erasers
- 1 12-Inch / Centimeter Ruler
- 1 24-count box of crayons (please, no larger packs; name on package is sufficient)
- 6 Solid-Colored pocket folders: 2 red, 2 blue, 1 green, and 1 purple
- 1 White dry erase board (approximately 8.5 x 11)
- 8-10 Dry erase markers (classic colors, no yellow or pink)
- 1 Small washcloth to be used as a white board eraser
- 1 or 2 The Pencil Grip brand grippers. Available at Learning World or online (\$1.85)
- 4 quarters, 10 dimes, 20 nickels, and 10 pennies (to be used for counting money in math). Please put coins in a Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name.
- \$10 art supply fee (for art teacher)

- New King James Version Bible

- 2 good erasers (block style or Clic style is fine)
- 1 package of 2 glue sticks
- 1 Dozen #2 Pencils or 2 mechanical pencils with lead refills
- 3 Packages loose leaf paper - College Rule
- 4 Large Dry erase markers (dark colors)
- 1 white dry erase board 9 x 12
- 9 Solid Colored 3 - Prong Folders w/pockets (any color)
- 1 1-inch binder with pockets
- 2 Boxes of facial tissues
